



Inescapable Conclusion.

We sometimes must draw a conclusion from the information given by command and/or example.







REMISSION OF SINS

"All have sinned and come short of the glory of God" - Romans 3:23

Remission of sins comes through the BLOOD OF JESUS

Matthew 26:28 (KJV)

For this is my blood of the new testament, which is shed for many for the remission of sins.

Remission of sins is associated with:

- PREACHING

ACTS 13:38

> BELIEVING

ACTS 10:43

- REPENTANCE

LUKE 4:47; ACTS 5:31; 26:18

> BAPTISM

ACTS 2:38

- SALVATION

LUKE 1:77

One is "lost" because of his sins. In order to be "saved" one must have his sins <u>forpiven</u> (the remission of sins). This is done through the <u>preaching</u> of the gospel of Jesus Christ. When one <u>believes</u> the message of the cross, <u>repents</u> of sin, and is <u>baptized</u> for the remission of his sins, he is then <u>saved</u> (cf. Mark 16:15-16). The Scriptures clearly reveal that each step is essential to having one's sins remitted. There are no short cuts to the grace of God!



Obedience To God's Command Results In:

Salvation

Our Reaching The Cross

THE NEW TESTAMENT

Mark 16:16

He that <u>believeth and is baptized shall be</u> <u>saved</u>; but he that believeth not shall be damned.

Acts 2:38

Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and <u>be</u> <u>baptized every one of you in the name of lesus Christ for the remission of sins</u>, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost.

Acts 22:16

And now why tarriest thou? arise, and be baptized, and wash away thy sins, calling on the name of the Lord.

John 3:5

Jesus answered, Verily, verily, I say unto thee, Except a man be born of water and of the Spirit, he cannot enter into the kingdom of God.

For as many of you as have been baptized into Christ have put on Christ.

Romans 6:3

Know ye not, that so many of us as were baptized into Jesus Christ were baptized into his death? (4) Therefore we are buried with him by baptism into death: that like as Christ was raised up from the dead by the glory of the Father, even so we also should walk in newness of life.

1 Peter 3:21

The like figure whereunto <u>even baptism</u> doth also now save us (not the putting away of the filth of the flesh, but the answer of a good conscience toward God,) by the resurrection of Jesus Christ:

THE TEACHING OF MEN

Men say: Belief alone will save you, baptism comes "after" salvation. It is done to show that you are already saved.

Men say: Baptism is **NOT** for the remission of sins.

Men say: Your sins are washed away "before" baptism. Saul (Paul) was saved on the road to Damascus.

Men say: The new birth has nothing to do with water.

Men say: Baptism doesn't put you "into Christ," but is the way one gets put into the church.

Men say: Your new life starts "before baptism" - Baptism is not the point of your new life/birth.

Men say: Baptism does not save you, nor does it have anything to do with your salvation.

(+) OR (-) ADDING TO OR SUBTRACTING FROM THE WORD OF GOD?

The Scriptures say:

Belief + Baptism = Salvation cf. Mark 16:16

"He that believeth and is baptized shall be saved; but he that believeth not shall be damned."

Repent + Baptism = Salvation cf. Acts 2:38

"Then Peter said unto them, Repent, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins, and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Ghost."

Confess + Baptism = Rejoicing cf. Acts 8:36-39

"And as they went on their way, they came unto a certain water: and the eunuch said, See, here is water; what doth hinder me to be baptized? (37) And Philip said, If thou believest with all thine heart, thou mayest. And he answered and said, I believe that Jesus Christ is the Son of God. (38) And he commanded the chariot to stand still: and they went down both into the water, both Philip and the eunuch; and he baptized him. (39) And when they were come up out of the water, the Spirit of the Lord caught away Philip, that the eunuch saw him no more: and he went on his way rejoicing."

Men Say:

"Faith alone" saves - Passage

Then, add:

Repentance Confession but, <u>subtract</u> baptism Question: By what rule do you "add" repentance and confession to "faith alone?"

"FOR THE REMISSION OF SINS"

Matthew 26:28 "For this is my blood of the covenant, which is poured out for many unto remission of sins." (ASV)

Greek: EIS APHESIS HARMARTION forgiveness sins

Acts 2:38 "And Peter said unto them, Repent ye, and be baptized every one of you in the name of Jesus Christ unto the remission of your sins; and ye shall receive the gift of the Holy Spirit." (ASV)


Greek: EIS APHESIS TON HARMARTION UMON gwith a view] to forgiveness of the sins of you

Some assert wrongfully that the Greek word "EIS" in Acts 2:38 should properly be understood to mean "because of," as in one is baptized "because his sins have <u>ALREADY</u> been forgiven." This false doctrine is exposed by looking at the same expression (for the remission of sins) in <u>Matthew 26:28</u>.

Here Jesus claims that the fruit of the vine in the cup represents His blood "which is poured out for many unto remission of sins." Was His blood on the cross to be poured out **BECAUSE** the sins of many had **ALREADY** been forgiven? Was His blood to flow on Calvary to **SHOW** that the forgiveness had been done sometime **BEFORE**? Of course not!

The New Testament scriptures teach that the act of baptism is essential to salvation. It is "unto" [with a view toward] the remission of one's sins - **Acts 2:38** - the same way that Jesus' death and shed blood were "unto" (for) the remission of sins.

THE LAST 24 HOURS

16 Fulfilled Prophecies

The Scriptures contain more than 300 prophecies that were fulfilled in Jesus, the Christ. The fulfillment of prophecy provides important evidence of the Divine Inspiration of the Bible. Fulfilled prophecy is also a powerful testimony to the true identity of Jesus - He is the *"only begotten Son of God."* Jesus acknowledged the role of prophecy and the importance of its fulfillment in the following statement:

Luke 24:44 (KJV) "And he said unto them, These are the words which I spake unto you, while I was yet with you, that all things must be fulfilled, which were written in the law of Moses, and in the prophets, and in the psalms, concerning me."

In the last 24 hour period of His life there are 16 distinct prophecies that were fulfilled, related to His betrayal, trial, crucifixion, and burial. These prophecies were revealed up to 1,000 years before Jesus was born and were written down in the Hebrew Scriptures. Many of these predictions were fulfilled by the enemies of Jesus, by men who would not knowingly fulfill a single verse of Scripture as it related to the Messiah and His death.

This is the "foundation text" for all millennial theories as it is the only place in the Scriptures where a thousand year period of time is spoken of with reference to the "reign of Christ." A careful look at this passage of Scripture will demonstrate that the premillennialist does not get his doctrine "**from**" this text, but rather is guilty of reading his supposed theory "**into**" the text.

The Scriptures warn against "adding to" and "taking away" from the inspired word of God (cf. Revelation 22:18-19). The danger of "reading into" a passage one's predetermined viewpoint is seen in the way many "interpret" Revelation 20:1-6. Instead of letting the passage (in it's context) reveal itself, many rush to an unjustified and false conclusion.


