The Nature of the Holy SpiritMisconceptions of the Holy Spirit

• "Holy Ghost"

- Something that is not real, fictitious
- Some mystical or magical being
- Think in terms of Hollywood type special effects
- Makes it difficult to think of the Holy Spirit as "real"

Misconceptions of the Holy Spirit

- Somehow different than other members of the Godhead
 - Somehow inferior to God the Father, and God the Son
 - As if there is some hierarchy among the Godhead

Misconceptions of the Holy Spirit

God the Son

God the Father

This is often the idea:

God the Father is somehow over the Son (as in superior), who is over the Holy Spirit (as in superior).

God the Holy Spirit

- God is God
 - There are no "degrees" of being God
 - All members of the Godhead are equal in being and power
 - The Holy Spirit is equal to the Son, who is equal to the Father

There is only ONE God

• Malachi 2:10a

Have we not all one Father? Has not one God created us?

Genesis 1:26-27

Then God said, "Let Us make man in Our image, according to Our likeness; let them have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over the cattle, over all the earth and over every creeping thing that creeps on the earth." So God created man in His *own* image in the image of God He created him; male and female He created them.

- There is only ONE God
 - Malachi 2:10
 - Genesis 1:26-27
- God is spoken of in both the plural and the singular
 - There is one God, and 3 members of the Godhead

Equality of the Godhead

- Establishing the equality of the Holy Spirit
- Consider creation:
 - Genesis 1:1-2

Consider the Creation Genesis 1:1-2

In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth. The earth was without form, and void; and darkness *was* on the face of the deep. And the Spirit of God was hovering over the face of the waters.

- All members of the Godhead were present at the creation
 - (Genesis 1:1-2; John 1:1-3; Colossians 1:15-18; Psalms 33:6-7; Job 26:13)
- Yet, Genesis 1:1 tells us simply that "God created"
 - Therefore all 3 are God, and equal in their existence

 The Spirit's Work in Creation – Gen 1:2; Psa 104:30

- Heavens Job 26:13; Psa 33:6
- All in conjunction with the works of the Word / Son – John 1:1-3; Col 1:16
- Mankind
 - First man Gen. 1:26

The Spirit's Work in Revelation
 In the Old Testament

- Prophets inspired 2 Pet 1:20-21; 2 Sam 23:2
- Spirit was "in them" 1 Pet 1:10-11
- In the New Testament
 - Spirit to guide in <u>all</u> truth
 - John 16:12-13 cf. John 14:26;

1 Cor 2:10-13

The Spirit's Work in Confirmation

 Confirming Jesus as the Christ
 Acts 2:22; Acts 10:38; Matt 12:28
 Luke 4:18-21

- Confirming the apostles of Christ
 - Confirmation of their message
 - Heb 2:3-4, Rom 15:9

The Spirit's Work in Regeneration

- As the Word was preached
 - Spirit convicting the world John 16:8, Acts 2:4 ff
- As the Word was obeyed
 - Those obedient: baptized! Acts 2:38-41
 - Baptized experienced regeneration
 - Titus 3:5-7; 1 Cor 6:11
 - John 3:5 "born again"

The Spirit's Work in Sanctification

- In our initial sanctification
 - 1 Cor 6:11, cf. 2 Thess 2:13
- Plays important role in living holy lives

Eph 3:16, 20; Rom 8:11-13; Col 3:5-9

The Spirit's Work in Intercession

- (Romans 8:26-27 NKJV) Likewise the Spirit also helps in our weaknesses. For we do not know what we should pray for as we ought, but the Spirit Himself makes intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered. {27} Now He who searches the hearts knows what the mind of the Spirit *is*, because He makes intercession for the saints according to the will of God.
